Well, now we have our own version!



- Egg Dino An exciting evening program where campers split into teams to protect their "nest" from the dinosaurs
- Evergreen The gymnasium and theatre space. Used for Performing Arts Night, Gymnastics Class, Blue/ Green Marble Pull, and many other camp events.
- Friendship Circle A nightly tradition where everyone holds hands and sings Peace and Taps to wish each other a goodnight.
- Highland Hall The dining hall where campers meet for delicious meals and homemade desserts
- **KOG** The Kids off the Grid program allows campers to spend a night camping in a tent and enjoying s'mores around a campfire.
- Lake Fairlee The beautiful body of water that Lochearn sits beside.
- Loon Black and white birds that call Lake Fairlee home. They are known for their recognizable song that can be heard each evening.
- OAP The Outdoor Adventure Program that allows campers to sign up for daily hikes in the area.
